



## Daniel POMMEREULLE

---

### PRESENTATION

Daniel Pommereulle passed away in December 2003, leaving a very diverse and complexe but also peculiar and premonitory work. According to Alain Jouffroy's phrase, he was associated to the "Objectors" (les "Objecteurs"). Despite some important exhibitions (*Fin de siècle* presented in 1975 at National Center for Contemporary Art - Georges Pompidou, or the retrospective exhibitions at the Dole and Belfort museums in 1991) and a growing aura, this work, certainly one of the most importants of the second half of the 20th century in France, remains unknown and secret.

From the 1980's to the 1990's he concentrates on the transparency theme with layouts of glass, paper and steel.

As an actor, he started with Eric Rohmer's *La Collectionneuse* in 1967 and played in a dozen of movies, among which François Truffau's *La mariée était en noir* (The Bride Wore Black), Jean-Luc Godard's *Week-End* and *Les Idoles* by Marc'O are noteworthy. In 1972, he takes part in *La Cicatrice Intérieure* (The Inner Scar) by Philippe Garrel whom he'll join again 27 years later for *Le Vent de la nuit* (Night Wind).

As a film director *One More Time* (1967) and *Vite* (*Fast*, 1969) are the most noticeable movies for which he successively created a suicide machine and shot sequences through a telephoto lens or a telescope, leading to an apology of the desert and the planet Saturn.

Leaves school and registers at the academy Julian in Paris to prepare the examination of Fine Arts school. Frequents Saint-Germain-des-Prés, museums, reads a lot, is interested in O. Redon and G. Moreau's works.

Is sent to Algeria.

##### 1959

Paints the series *Nuages* and *Crepuscules* (lost).

At the Flore, meets M. Ernst, R. Matta, A. Jouffroy, Erro who takes him to Italy, where he meets F. Hundertwasser, E. Dietman, J-J. Lebel and sees the notebooks of Leonard de Vinci.

##### 1960

Paints the series *Spirales*, exposed at the "Anti-Procès III", organized at the Galleria Brera in Milan by A. Jouffroy and J-J Lebel.

Stays in Venice.

##### 1961

"Anti-procès III".

Experiments the psilocybine with a psychiatrist of Sainte Anne Hospital in Paris.

##### 1962

First solo show, Galleria Antichita in Ravenna (Italy), inks executed in Venice.  
Begins a new series of paintings with objects on white background. Creates paintings with laden or exploded firecrackers.

Exhibition at the Galerie Cordier, Paris. First exhibition of Daniel Pommereulle in France.  
Participates in happenings (Allan Kaprow, J.-J. Lebel), realizes two : *L'En-Dehors* (Galerie R. Cordier, Paris), *Kiss me* (at the Workshop of the free expression of J.-J. Lebel and C. Schneemann, and the Collage Happening organized by Michael White at Denison Hall, London.)  
Begins his first assemblages of objects (series of *Objets oubliés*).
